Our Social Media and our Members

The Club may use photo/s/video/s (with you in) on social media platforms which may directly influence the positivity of the club.

All photos/videos are to be posted to **CLOSED** social media platforms that the club runs; **ALL** photos posted in open forums or controlled by other parties will be subject to your approval before posting.

Photos can be blurred/cropped to provide anonymity if needed.

Images will not be tagged with names of individuals by the club, however members are welcome to comment and share as applicable.

Who regulates the media outlets?

The people controlling the Social Media accounts are predominantly the committee members of the Club but also, trusted individuals within Prorsum Semper.

Removal of Images

In the event that you wish a particular photo or video to be removed from an open platform, please contact the committee Prorsumsemper@glosmasons.org.uk to request this.

As well as Prorsum Semper there may be photos/videos used by the Province on their social media outlets, Square Talk and maybe other Light Blues/NYMC's if any cross-club events are held.

Any issues with this you would need to contact the other parties direct to request removal.
